

UCO Bank Q2FY26 results: Net profit increases 2.82% to Rs. 620 crore

Chennai, oct 18: Kolkata-based state-owned UCO Bank reported a 2.82 per cent increase in net profit to rs.620 crore for the second quarter of the financial year 2025-26 (Q2FY26) from the rs.603 crore in the same period last year. The bank's asset quality improved as gross non-performing assets (NPAs) declined to 2.56 per cent of gross advances at the end of the second quarter, from 3.18 per cent a year ago. Similarly, net NPAs, or bad loans, declined to 0.43 per cent from 0.73 per cent in the year-ago period. The Provision Coverage Ratio stood at 96.99 per cent as of September 2025. Ashwani Kumar, UCO

Bank's managing director and chief executive officer, in the post results press conference, said that UCO Bank has been awarded Runner-up for the Best Performance on Growth (Mid- Size Public Sector bank) at the 3rd Emerging Asia Banking Awards 2025, Organized by the Indian Chamber of Commerce (ICC) The Retail, Agriculture, and MSME (RAM) segment registered a year-on-year growth of 22.87 per cent, reaching rs.1,32,946 crore as of September 30, 2025. Within this segment, retail advances grew by 25.40 per cent year-on-year to rs.58,987 crore, agriculture advances increased by 17.28 per



cent to rs.31,650 crore, and MSME advances rose by 23.80 per cent to rs.42,309 crore. The bank's net interest income (NII) grew by 8.36 per cent on Y-o-Y to rs.4936 crore for the half year ended September 2025 as against rs.4555 crore for the half year ended September 2024. Net interest margin (NIM)-

global stood at 2.90 per cent and domestic NIM at 3.08 per cent for the second quarter. As on September 30, UCO Bank had a network of 3,322 domestic branches and 2 overseas branches each at Hong Kong and Singapore and 1 Representative Office in Iran. Out of the total branches, Bank has 2,037 (61 per cent) branches in rural & semi-urban areas. Bank has 2,607 ATMs and 11,108 BC Points making the total number of 17,040 touch points. The bank's business per employee improved to rs.25.17 crore as on September 2025 as against rs.22.10 crore for the same period of preceding year.

The selected survivors' families were then presented with helmets as a mark of recognition. The helmets were distributed

by AIIMS Patna's Executive Director Prof. (Brigadier) Raju Agrawal, Medical Superintendent Prof. (Dr.) Anup Kumar, and Head of Trauma Surgery and Critical Care Department Dr. Anil Kumar. The beneficiaries included Aman from Ara, Devanshu from Nalanda, Sanjay from Ara, Akshay from Jehanabad, and Virendra Das from Motihari. The families

expressed their gratitude and pledged to spread the message of helmet safety within their communities.
